## Apple (or pumpkin\*) Paper Craft

## You will need:

12 to 16 red and/or green paper strips, 8.5" x 1" wide

1 piece of yarn or string, about 11" long

Hole punch, or something to make a hole (scissors, nail, etc.)

1 bead (pony beads work well)

1 green leaf shape (template below)


Small pieces of tape

Fairy lights (optional)

- 1. Arrange your cut strips of paper in a pile. Punch a hole through each end of the whole pile, like this:
- 2. Feed one end of the cord through one open hole of the strips. Tape the end of the cord to the paper to secure.
- 3. Feed the loose end of the cord through the other hole (do not tape this one).
- 4. Hold your paper strip bundle by the loose end of the cord.
- 5. Push the strips down to bend them until the ends are about 3" apart.
- 6. String your bead onto the cord and tie a knot where you've bent the strips to hold them in position.
- 7. Tape a leaf to the cord by the bead . (you can fold the bottom tab of the leaf over the cord).
- 8. Tie a loop in the loose end of the cord for hanging.
- 9. Gently fan out the strips to make your 'apple'. (You can put a small piece of tape in the bottom center of your apple to help the strips stay in place.)

## *Notes:*

You can string fairy lights through your apple to make a lantern. \*Use orange paper to make pumpkins and tape or glue black triangles on for eyes.
