[Scarlatti, Sonata in C minor FUGUE \(K. 58\)](#) Stephen Malinowski has made hundreds of videos like this, with a graphical representation of what's going on in the piece. Here's a little fugue by Domenico Scarlatti, an Italian keyboard composer born in the same year as Bach and Handel (1685). It's based on a simple descending chromatic theme.

[Bach: Mass in B minor - Crucifixus - Herreweghe](#) Bach used this same idea when setting the words "was crucified for us, died, and was buried" in his B Minor Mass. The endlessly falling theme lends itself to many rich chords, and a tragic feeling. Other famous examples of the chromatic fourth are "When I am laid in earth" by Purcell, and "Stairway to Heaven" by Led Zeppelin!

Choir practice is on Thursday evenings at 7:00 p.m. All are welcome!

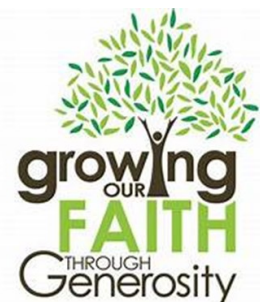
BOARD OF MINISTRIES MEETING
