"Next to the Word of God, Music Deserves the Highest Praise" -Martin Luther
[Tchaikovsky - October, Autumn Song \(from The Seasons, Op. 37a\) - Cyprien Katsaris Piano](#) It's autumn, and this time of year has inspired a lot of great music. Here's "Autumn Song," by Tchaikovsky. Almost every beat in this piece has an accented dissonance in the melody (where the melodic line's note isn't part of the chord, though it soon resolves to a chord note). This is a classic way of making the music feel like it's sighing, or yearning for something – very nostalgic!

[Strauss-Vier Letzte Lieder-September-Haitink|Concertgebouworkest](#) There's a lot to unpack in this piece. Strauss wrote these "Four Last Songs" in his 80s, soon after World War II and right before his death. This one, "September," is about a garden going to sleep at the end of summer, with obvious metaphorical implications. There's a lovely horn solo toward the end, which seems to have been a nostalgic reference to his father, who had been a horn player.
